Welcome	Welcome and introductions	
Recap and introduction	Scope drivers include concepts for health summary, transfer of care summary, chronic disease management, decision support, and referral	
Data Models	 Referring to what the patient is currently taking in a summary statement Discussion during meeting: There was discussion around the medication names in reference to active ingredient and brand name and start end dates for medication prescription. Vital Signs and Measurements Designed to support chronic disease management and clinical decision support 	

- Discussion during meeting: Discussion about what is in scope for R1 and future considerations
 - Heart rhythm is out of scope for R1
 - BMI may be of higher value than waist circumference when determining cardiovascular risk
 - Fields available for recording detailed information for blood pressure and atrial fibrillation

Clinical Encounters

- Captures the reason a patient has initiated a healthcare encounter from the clinician perspective and the modality of the encounter (e.g. clinic, home visit)
- Discussion during meeting: There was discussion around terminology and clinician perspective of encounter
 - Differentiation between a planned review and patient recall

Sex and Gender

- Sex assigned at birth v gender identity
- Discussion during meeting: Discussion of importance of creating a data element with clear distinction of biological sex and gender identity
 - No concerns around the inclusion of these items were raised
