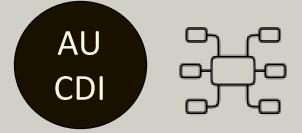

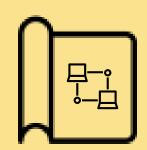
CDG is here

(and corresponding data elements and terms) should be included for data entry, data use and sharing information supporting patient care






Specifies "HOW" the core set of data (above) and information should be <u>structured</u>, <u>accessed</u> and <u>shared</u> between systems

## Tobacco smoking summary



#### Per type group

- Description: Details about smoking activity for a specified type of tobacco.
- Allows for a repeating set of data elements for each type of tobacco smoked

#### Type

- **Description** The type of tobacco smoked.
- Value set to be determined eg Cigarette, Cigar, Pipe etc

#### Status

- Description: Statement about smoking habits for the specified type of tobacco.
- Value set Current smoker/Former smoker/Never smoked

#### Typical use (units)

- **Description** Estimate of the typical amount smoked over a lifetime by 'sticks' or units.
- For example: 10-20/day or 15/week

#### Typical use (mass)


- **Description** Estimate of the typical amount of loose-leaf tobacco smoked over a lifetime by weight.
- For example: 10-15g/day or 50g/week

#### Comment

• **Description** - Additional narrative about smoking of the <u>specified type of</u> tobacco, not captured in other fields.



## Tobacco smoking summary



#### Overall quit date

• **Description**: The date when the individual last ceased using tobacco of <u>any type</u>.

#### Overall years of smoking

• **Description**: Estimate of the <u>total number of years</u> that the individual has smoked any tobacco.

#### Overall pack years

• **Description**: Estimate of the <u>cumulative amount of tobacco</u> smoked for all types.

#### Overall comment

 Description: Additional narrative about <u>all tobacco</u> smoking that has not been captured in other fields.



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
## Alcohol consumption summary


**Concept description** - summary information about an individual's pattern of consuming alcohol and alcohol-containing products.



## Alcohol consumption summary



#### Overall Status

- Description: Statement about current consumption habits for all types of alcohol
- **Value set** *Current drinker/Former drinker/Lifetime non-drinker*

#### Overall comment

- **Description** Additional narrative about all alcohol consumption, not been captured in other fields.
- Free text

#### Last updated

• **Description**: The date when this 'Alcohol consumption summary' data group was last updated.





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## Substance use summary

• **Concept description** - summary information about an individual's typical pattern of use of a specified substance or class of substances that may harm an individual's health or social well-being.

## "Substance use" scope

#### Inclusion:


- Substances that fall within the scope of this data group include <u>harmful or potentially addictive substances as well as medications that are misused</u>. Medication misuse may involve administration without clinical supervision, use for non-recommended purposes, or consumption in quantities or frequencies that exceed safe dosages.
- Examples of substances that may be recorded using this data group include but are not limited to:
  - · caffeine;
  - nicotine and other clinically significant components of vaping liquid;
  - Psychostimulants, barbiturates, cannabis, hallucinogens, opioids, GHB, MDMA;
  - sniffing of hydrocarbons or other solvents;
  - · "bath salts"; and
  - medication 'misuse', such as
    - a laxative for purposes other than relief of constipation,
    - beta blockers to reduce the heart rate in elite athletes, and
    - · anabolic steroids in weightlifters.

#### **Exclusion:**

- On the other hand, <u>substances that are commonly recorded in health records and are (or will be) recorded using existing purpose-specific data groups</u>, are excluded from the scope of this data group, including:
  - tobacco smoking;
  - smokeless tobacco use;
  - alcohol consumption;
  - vaping; and
  - medication administration according to established medical guidelines and standards, including the correct dosage and appropriate indication, timing and route of administration.



## Substance use summary



#### Substance name

- **Description**: The name of the substance or class of substance.
- **Value set** Coding with an external terminology is preferred, where possible.

#### Overall Status

- **Description**: Statement about current substance use, for all forms and all routes of administration.
- Value set Current user/Former user/Never used

#### Overall comment

- **Description** Additional narrative about overall use of the substance, not been captured in other fields.
- Free text

#### Last updated

• **Description**: The date when this 'Substance use summary' data group was last updated.



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



# Goals and Health issues

## Goal

 Concept description - A specific future objective intended to improve or maintain an individual's physical, mental, emotional or social well-being.

Can be initiated by a clinician or the individual







# Goal name Description Clinical indication Start date Proposed end date Actual end date Comment Protocol Last updated

Goals of care

#### Goal name

- **Description**: The name or focus of the well-being objective.
- For example: reduced blood pressure; achieved weight loss; or diabetes control.

#### Goal description

• **Description**: A narrative description of the goal, including target/s to be achieved if relevant.

#### Clinical indication

• **Description**: The health issue, symptom, sign, problem or diagnosis intended to be impacted by achieving the goal.

#### Start date

• **Description**: The date when the activities designed to achieve the goal were initiated.

#### Proposed end date

• **Description**: The desired or proposed date for achieving the goal.

#### Actual end date

• **Description**: The actual date when the goal was achieved or abandoned.

#### Outcome

- **Description**: Single word, phrase or brief description which represents the outcome achieved.
- Coding with a terminology is preferred, where possible.
- For example: target weight achieved; poor diabetes control; or successful completion.

#### Comment

• **Description**: Additional narrative about the goal, not captured in other fields.

#### Last updated

**Description**: The date when this 'Goal' data group was last updated.




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




## Health Issue

- **Concept description** Any <u>concern or worry</u> that can negatively affect an individual's physical, mental, or emotional well-being or quality of life.
- Can be identified by a clinician or the individual.





- "Health concern" not proposed as a name to avoid confusion:
- Used differently in different standards contexts, for example
  - HL7 US Core Condition Problems and Health concerns profile
    - inherits from the Condition resource (= Problem/Diagnosis data group)
  - CONTSYS Health condition is a type of health record extract

Potential related future data groups:



- Recommendation

NOTE: If a concern or worry needs to be recorded within a Problem list, it should be recorded using a more specific Problem/Diagnosis data group

• **Description**: The name of the health concern or worry.

• **Description**: A narrative description about the health issue.

#### Date of onset

• **Description**: The date when the health issue began.

#### Last updated

• **Description**: The date when this 'Health issue' data group was last updated.

## Definition - proposal

### Intervention

A single therapeutic activity, or a series of activities, intended to prevent, diagnose, treat, or manage health conditions, support mental or physical well-being, or address social and environmental factors that influence health outcomes.

## Definitions - proposal

### Follow-up

The <u>process</u> of delivering ongoing, intentional care by a healthcare provider, beyond the initial appointment or intervention.

Follow-up is typically used to track progress, manage ongoing treatment, and assess the outcomes of previous interventions. This process commonly involves scheduling one or more follow-up activities at intervals recommended by the healthcare provider, each tailored to the condition and specific needs of the individual.

For example: a single six-week post-surgery check-up to assess healing and recovery; 6 monthly liver function tests after commencing a hepatotoxic medication; regular 3 monthly visits with a podiatrist to manage long-term foot care; or a palliative care nurse making twice-daily home visits until the end of an individual's life.

#### Recall

A clinician-initiated <u>action</u> to proactively address an emerging health concern, in a known individual.

A recall is typically associated with the detection of a potential health need or risk since the last appointment or contact, and the recall advice is sent or given to the individual with the intent they receive the necessary follow-up care to effectively and safely manage or monitor their health.

For example: if an abnormality is found in test results, the individual may be recalled for additional testing or treatment.

### Reminder

A clinical <u>notification</u> sent to an individual regarding their scheduled, routine, and preventive health and care activities.

A reminder is typically an automated or system-generated message, such as email or text, that proactively help individuals, carers, and families stay up-to-date with regular preventive health activities and appointments.

For example: reminding the individual about routine vaccinations; or regular cancer screenings that are due or scheduled.



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
